LOCATION

- Dolphin Island lies off shore from the tip of Viti Levu, Fiji, surrounded by crystal-clear waters.
- From Nadi International Airport guests are transferred by private vehicle to Rakiraki. This 2.5 hour journey ends as guests embark from Wananavu Wharf by private boat on a 20-minute voyage to Dolphin Island. Seaplane & helicopter transfers also available though not included in tariff. Seaplane 45 minutes, helicopter 35, minutes one way. Helipad within grounds.

ACCOMMODATION

- Just four luxurious guest bure suites, configured as two pairs, either side of the main bure pavilion. Maximum occupancy 8 guests, on an exclusive-use basis.
- Each guest bure suite contains bedroom with king-size bed, desk and comfortable seating. Fine pure cotton bed linen and down and feather pillows. Solid timber floors.
- Generous dressing room – designed for individual use by a couple.
- En suite bathrooms are beautifully appointed. Stone floor tiles, free-standing bath and separate showers (indoor and outdoor), stunning shell and coral mirrors and Pure Fiji toiletries.
- Air conditioning, ceiling fans and open wooden shutters (with insect proofing) all ensure comfortable temperatures at all times.
- The romantic hilltop sleep-out bure is an utterly divine, thatched open-air bedroom. Both rustic and refined, no electricity – lanterns & candles only, with shower and flush toilet.
- Check-in & out is flexible, according to arrival/departure times of guests and their individual travel plans.

RECREATION

- The infinity pool is freshwater, all one depth and perfect for a refreshing dip.
- The beach boasts white sand and the water is clean, clear and great for swimming and snorkelling.
- A Hobie Catamaran and sea kayaks are available for guest use.
- Pampering facials and relaxing massages are available on request.
- Aquatic activities such as diving and fishing are available, using carefully selected local operators.
- Cultural activities include on-island performances as well as visits further afield, by arrangement.
