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

Transfer to Juliaca Airport with a stop at the ancient gravesite at Sillustani, famous for it's impressive funerary towers which reach up to 12 metres in height. Fly to Lima and overnight at an airport hotel.

DAY 20 LIMA

Depart Lima. Extensions are available to other parts of South America including the Galapagos Islands.
