




Our weather – what to expect


Despite Queenstown's relatively high altitude it experiences an oceanic climate. Summer has long warm days with temperatures that can reach 30°C. Winters are mild for a subalpine climate, with average highs reaching double digits. Occasional arctic cold fronts deliver snowfall, however Lake Wakatipu's consistent temperature acts as a thermal sink to keep the surrounds largely defrosted. The weather is quite dynamic and sun is strong. Always pack for three seasons, because you're likely to experience all three.
